<u>Suggested supplies</u>: If you do not have some of these supplies at home, and it is difficult to get them you can get by with the materials you do have.

Supplies:

- Sketchbook (8"x10" or larger) and pencils/eraser for preliminary sketching, any kind will work, just whatever you are comfortable sketching with
- You will need a small drawing board to support 8"x10" silverpoint paper. A
 clipboard or a piece of foamcore with clips works great if you don't have a
 drawing board.
- Silverpoint tools and prepared paper will be provided.

Additional supply info:

- Silverpoint drawing tools will be loaned out during the workshop. It's easy to make your own, and a demonstration for a few methods for making your own drawing tools will be covered during the workshop.
- Coated paper will also be provided.
- All you need to bring is a small drawing board or clipboard to support the 8"x10" silverpoint paper.
- You may also want to bring along a small sketchbook and pencil for taking notes and for warmup/preliminary sketches.
 - Any sketchbook will do, but if you would like a recommendation, I like Strathmore 400 series drawing pads.
