<u>Suggested supplies</u>: If you do not have some of these supplies at home, and it is difficult to get them you can get by with the materials you do have.

Birch Baltic bark 12x12" panels and white acrylic primer are provided.

## Supplies to bring to class:

- Acrylic paint, any brand (at least 3 colors plus black and white)
- 1" and 2" flat wide brushes (inexpensive bristle brushes from Home Depot are just fine)
- Palette knifes (we can discuss options in class)
- Small piece of fine sandpaper
- Variety of sketching tools such as: soft graphite pencils, grease pencil, wax or oil pastels/crayons, water soluble crayons, (we can discuss more options in class)
- Any sharp metal tools to scratch into paint
- Large palette or cafeteria tray lined with parchment paper for mixing colors (we can discuss more in first class)
- Metal ruler
- Masking or blue painter's tape
- Large water container to rinse brushes (large yogurt container works great)
- Small spray bottle
