- machine stitched (outside of class), like patchwork, clothing, or a bag and augmented with hand stitching
- up-cycled clothing, or anything you want to mend or embellish with hand stitching
- an expansion of something you want to explore - a cloth book, a sampler, a series, collage or mixed media
- suggested by the instructor, if you need ideas

- a basic sewing kit
- a sketchbook or notebook
- the supplies necessary for your project
- a scrap of fabric and thread to try things out
