Suggested supplies: *If you do not have some of these supplies at home, and it is difficult to get them you can get by with the materials you do have. Or you can purchase as we go – so pay attention to the lists on the schedule please.*

Paint: 6 tubes (colors), can get you by (Daniel Smith brand listed here, but you can use the pigment numbers to find the same color in other brands):

- Hansa Yellow Deep PPY65
- Lemon Yellow PY175
- Phthalo Blue GSPB15:3
- French Ultramarine PB29
- Quinacridone rose PB19
- Pyrrol Scarlet PR255

Recommended brands: Windsor Newton professional grade, Grumbacher artist quality, Dick Blick Artist Quality, Daniel Smith Artist Quality, M.Graham, Turner

Brushes:

- Round – size 4, 8 and 12
- Flat - 1/2” flat brush
- Rigger or script brush

Suggested brands: Princeton, Windsor Newton, Danube, Black Velvet
NO - Master’s Touch

Pencil and kneadable eraser

Paper: 140lb cold press watercolor paper – Fabriano brand. Don’t get cheap paper!
Individual sheets are best, Block is fine too.

Foam board: 1/2” thick foam board – can be found at graphics companies or art supplies and light duty staple gun

Palette: White – can be top of whip cream container, white plate, enamel pan, plastic lid, egg plate

Palette knife

Masking Fluid (Liquid Frisket): Incredible White Mask recommended + cheap brush
Frisket Lifter

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES: (the dollar store can be your friend)

- 2 containers for water – can be plastic containers, glasses
- Masking tape
- White, (no printed patterns) paper towels or shop towels
- Sketch book (copy paper will do)
- Spray bottle
- salt container
- cellophane or plastic wrap
- dish soap or bar soap
- old plastic card, razor blade, drinking straw, old toothbrush,
- sea sponges – look for interesting textures
- drinking straw and/or coffee stirring stick
- white acrylic paint (inexpensive)
- small pliers or nutcracker
- magic eraser – plain, without soap
- eye dropper
- scissors
- Container(s) to keep it all in
